In summary, we recorded 8 critically endangered, 4 endangered, 8 vulnerable and 7 data

deficient species in 2013. 2 previously thought extinct species (Clipper & Malay Yeoman) were re-sighted.

Purple Spotted Flitter (a previously unreliably identified species) was also resighted.
