What is an Eco-Journey?

NSS Eco-Journeys are thoughtfully curated overseas learning experiences set within living landscapes.

Participants visit conservation sites, engage with local communities and champions, experience nature up close, and reflect on what sustainability looks like in practice.

Each Eco-Journey is designed and led by the **Directors of Nature Society Singapore**, in partnership with leaders from regional communities and NGOs.

About Eco- Journey (Pak Thale)

Eco-Journey (Pak Thale) is designed for participants to experience the following:

1) Land Ownership & Use: Understand how land ownership and use can shape conservation outcomes, with insights from the Bird Conservation Society of Thailand and guided birdwatching at protected plots.

2) Connectedness to Nature: Experience traditional salt-farming, explore coastal ecosystems and join community boat rides; these activities highlight the interdependence between people and nature.

3) Sustainable Cities in Practice: Collaborate with schools in soap-making and explore waste management at the Laem Pak Bia Environmental R&D project (LERD) to see how community-driven initiatives contribute to stewardship and sustainable living.
